St George's is a school with 1369 pupils. There are both boys and girls from the ages of 11 to 19.

About 112 pupils are boarders and live in the Boarding Houses. The boys' Boarding House is called Crosthwaite and the girls' Boarding House is called Keswick.

St. George's is organised into Houses. You will belong to one of these until you leave school.

These are:

GODDARD	(House colour RED)	Head of House is Mr Day
GRANT	(House colour GREEN)	Head of House is Mr Muriss
MONK	(House colour BLUE)	Head of House is Mr Ede
WATTS	(House colour YELLOW)	Head of House is Mr Harris

There is a team of 13 tutors in each House. You will be put into a House and a tutor group. If you have brothers and sisters, you will be in the same House.

If you have any concerns you should always go to your tutor, if possible. Otherwise talk to any member of staff or a prefect.

Fire

In an emergency the overriding principle is to save lives and **you are expected to act with common sense at all times.**

The fire alarm is the normal siren but it keeps sounding continuously, it does not stop.

Each room has a fire notice. Make sure you are familiar with the routes from each room you have lessons in.

You should leave the room and buildings **in silence** as quickly as possible.

Leave your bags in the room.

Go to the MUGA (Multi Use Games Area).

Starting at the end of the MUGA nearest to the Boys Boarding House, line up in your tutor groups in register order as follows:

GODDARD, GRANT, MONK, WATTS.

Your tutors will check that everyone is present. Remain lined up in silence until your Head of House dismisses you.

It is important to remain in silence so that you can hear any instructions.
