General Expectations Agreement

Students are expected to commit to the academic standards and discipline policies set by their Consortium School in order to thrive in their chosen subject.

Attendance

Students are required to attend the Consortium School's lessons even if their Home School has a different arrangement (such as an Inset Day, early closure etc).

Students are required to inform their teachers at the Consortium School in advance of any foreseen attendance problems via email with a cc to the Head of Sixth Form at their Home School. Students must catch up on any missed work.

Students are required to register their attendance by signing in and out at the Consortium School. This is especially important for health and safety reasons. If a student has a consortium lesson period 1, then they should to go straight to the consortium school, and not register at St George's first, they should inform their tutor.
