 - ARE THE SPELLING OF YOUR NAME AND DATE OF BIRTH CORRECT?
 - YOU MUST KNOW YOUR CANDIDATE NUMBER AND USE IT ON ALL WRITTEN EXAM PAPERS (AND WORD PROCESSED SCRIPTS IF YOU USE A WORD PROCESSOR) AND ANY NEA. USING THE WRONG NUMBER MAY CAUSE A DELAY IN ISSUING YOUR RESULTS IN THE SUMMER.
- 2. ONLY THE QUALIFICATION NAME AND OVERALL SUBJECT CODE WILL APPEAR. PROVIDED THE CODE IS CORRECT (YOU CAN CHECK ON THE SPREADSHEET ON THE SCHOOL WEBSITE [MENU > SCHOOL LIFE > EXAMS > EXAM INFORMATION > GCSE EXAMINATIONS AT ST GEORGES 2023 2024] OR ON THE RESPECTIVE EXAM BOARD WEBSITES), IT IS SAFE TO ASSUME THAT YOU WILL AUTOMATICALLY BE ENTERED FOR ALL THE CORRECT UNITS, WHETHER WRITTEN OR NEA.
