A pass in a GCSE subject is indicated by one of the nine grades from 9 to 1 of which 9 is the highest and 1 is the lowest. Candidates whose level of achievement is below 1 will receive an unclassified result U. For Combined Science (Trilogy) students receive a double grade, made up of two equal or adjacent grades, where 9-9 is the highest, followed by 9-8, then 8-8 and so on down to 1-1

Unclassified results are not recorded on certificates.
