St George's needs your help

July 2012 brought change to St George's when it was agreed to move to Academy status. This conversion was in line with the Government's plans for a reformed system of strong, autonomous schools and a modernised role for local authorities.

Academy status has allowed us to continue our focus on raising standards and broadening opportunity for all our students including maintaining our role as one of the leading state boarding schools in the country. Boarding remains an important part of the school's work.

We have retained, protected and enhanced the established ethos of St George's School and remain a non-denominational Christian school with the same expectations about Church membership in our admissions criteria for family Chapel attendance each term.

St George's is held in high regard by parents and its community and we remain committed to serving our local community.

St George's has never been a wealthy school. It has few endowments and no links with any rich charities. Although Academy status gives us some flexibility with the distribution of our funds, we remain reliant on the continued support and generosity of our current families and past generations of Georgians.

We are asking you to consider joining those who have left or are leaving a legacy to St George's by making a provision in your Will. A legacy is a gift that nearly everybody can make; especially for those who are less able to give during their lifetime, as a legacy gift offers a unique and genuine opportunity to make a huge impact.

A guide to leaving a Legacy to St George's School, Harpenden Academy Trust – 311050

If you would like to include St George's School in your Will you should arrange with a solicitor to either write a Will or amend your existing Will by the addition of a Codicil. This needs to be separately signed, dated and witnessed by two Witnesses as for a Will.

A suggested form of wording for a Will or Codicil is;

I GIVE to ST GEORGE'S SCHOOL, SUN LANE, HARPENDEN, AL5 4TD (Charity Registration Number 311050) the residue or a proportion of the residue of my estate or the sum of £ (amount) free of tax for the Directors to apply in such a manner as they in their absolute discretion think fit for the benefit of the School. I declare that the receipt of the School Business Manager for the time being of the School shall be a good and sufficient discharge to my Executors.

The following are ways in which could provide for a legacy to the school.

Specific Legacy

This means you leave a gift of a specific possession to the School; this may be in the form of property, valuables, works of art or stocks and shares.

Pecuniary Legacy

This means you leave a gift of a specific amount of money to the school.

Residuary Legacy

This means you leave a percentage of the residue of your Estate after any bequests have been made.

Reversionary Gift

This allows for your Estate, or particular assets, to be passed to your spouse, children or other named individuals, for their lifetime and on their death the whole or a portion of these assets revert to St George's School.

UK Inheritance Tax

As St George's is a Registered Charity a legacy made direct to St George's using the form provided will be free of Inheritance Tax. This applies to any legacy whether Residuary, Pecuniary or Specific.
