We would like to invite you to an Information Evening for parents and students regarding Post-18 Progression.

The majority of our students apply for Higher Education courses but increasingly students are recognising alternative ways forward through school leaver programmes, (degree) apprenticeships, employment and/or gap year placements. We have held a series of online talks this term for the students to find out more about some of their options. This will be followed with a series of interactive booklets regarding the different Post-18 options, which will give a wealth of information regarding 18+ pathways and full guidance on all Post-18 applications. Parents and students will be given access to these following the 18+ Information Webinar.

For students considering university in the UK, the application process is done via UCAS and the application process begins in June 2021, with the intention of sending these to the universities by the end of October 2021. St George's encourages all students to complete a UCAS application in order to learn how to fill out such a form (including a personal statement).

Whilst we appreciate and understand that finding a work experience placement may not be possible for many of our students, we are still encouraging students to try and seek this opportunity, either in person, or virtually, and at this stage, we still plan to run this in Activities Week next term.

Students will be required to complete the Activities Week 2021 Planned Activities sheet (attached) next half term, so that we can record where all students are during this week, and who will be in School to work with Miss Morris and Mrs Turner. We will require this form by Friday, 28th May 2021. If undertaking work experience, the student must ensure that they also complete and return a Sixth Form Work Experience Placement Form (attached) to Miss Morris no later than Friday, 18th June 2021. Also attached is the Sixth Form Work Experience Booklet for completion by the student and their work placement supervisor. This paperwork will also be available on the School Website (Pupils Area > For Sixth Form Students > Sixth Form Letters and Forms).
